CD5 Satellite Project

Dear Mr. Perham:

ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. (CPAI) hereby submits this request for a Letter of Authorization for the Incidental Take of Polar Bears for the CD5 satellite development project. The proposed project is located in and just west of the Colville River Delta on the North Slope of Alaska. The CD5 project includes a new drill site and associated road and pipelines and will be constructed over the period of 2010 - 2012. The project, including location maps and a preliminary construction schedule, is detailed in the attached Project Description. This request is submitted to fulfill the requirements of 50 CFR Part 18 regarding the incidental, unintentional "take" of protected marine mammals. The project was also evaluated in the Alpine Satellite Development Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement issued by the Bureau of Land Management in September 2004.

In past years, CPAI prepared a Polar Bear/Personnel Encounter Plan covering each of the proposed projects for the upcoming winter season. CPAI now has in place a polar bear plan titled "Polar Bear Avoidance and Interaction Plan: February 2008" that covers all Alpine satellite oil and gas development areas. This plan has been reviewed and approved by the USFWS. CPAI will comply with the requirements of that plan during activities associated with the CD5 project. Due to the distance between the prime coastal and river habitats and the CD5 project area, the potential for human/polar bear interaction is generally considered small.
