

# Process for Fly In / Fly Out and Transportation Services for ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar

**This notification** is intended to address the fly in and fly out and transportation process at the ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar. Updates will be provided as new questions arise and the situation evolves.

Employees and contractors are directed to use the ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar for boarding and deplaning. The hangar is located at 6601 South Airpark Place, Anchorage, AK, 99502.

Starting March 31, bus transportation to/from the ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar will be provided. Refer to table below for pick up / drop off times and locations.

BAC Transportation	Captain Cook Hotel	ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar	2 hours and 30 minutes before scheduled flight
BAC Transportation	Anchorage International Airport (Pick up at the Taxi-Tour Bus Stop outside baggage claim no. 5 on the lower level)	ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar	2 hours before scheduled flight
BAC Transportation	ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar	Anchorage International Airport (Drop off at the Taxi-Tour Bus Stop outside baggage claim no. 5 on the lower level)	30 minutes after arrival at hangar

Other long-term parking vendors, such as Diamond Parking, may be able to provide transportation to and from the ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar. Please check with parking vendors for more information and availability.

**NORTHBOUND PASSENGERS:** Passengers should report two hours prior to departure and enter through the front door where they will be met by a ticketing agent for entry to the facility. The hangar will be used for ticketing, security screening and boarding.

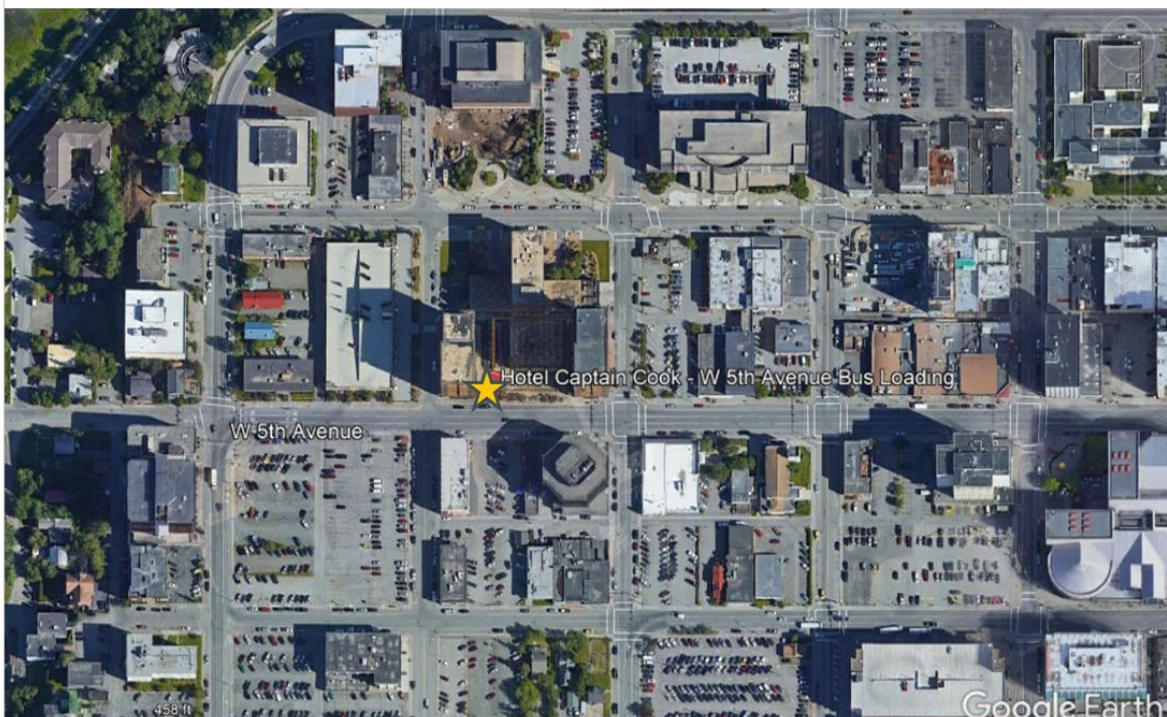
**SOUTHBOUND PASSENGERS:** Deplaning will occur at the ConocoPhillips Alaska Aviation Hangar. Passengers will remain on the aircraft until baggage is unloaded and placed in the hangar. Once the baggage has been unloaded, passengers will be escorted into the hangar to pick up baggage and to continue through the hangar to exit out the front door.

Bus transportation as provided in the table above will be available for transport for those with connecting flights or for those with vehicles parked at the Anchorage Airport.

A pickup location is available on the south side of the hangar for passengers who have made other arrangements and do not require the bus for transportation. Those picking up a passenger will not be allowed in the hangar and should remain in the vehicle.
