Baggage Requirements

- All baggage and hand carry items being transported on ConocoPhillips aircraft, are subject to xray and/or search
- Passengers may check-In 4 pieces of baggage, weighing up to 50 pounds each
 - Approval required for exceptions
 - Please contact Aviation Operations Support at (907) 263-3500 option 1 or aosup@conocophillips.com
- Items exceeding 50 pounds
 - Passenger will be required to repack items to meet requirements. Anchorage Ticket Counter will not provide boxes
 - Items that cannot be broken down, must be shipped as belly freight. This must be coordinated with the passenger's company representative and Aviation Operations Support
- Passengers will be allowed one personal item
 - i.e., purse, small briefcase, laptop computer, camera bag, etc.
- Passengers will be allowed one carry-on bag
 - Cannot exceed the measurements of 14" H x 8"W x 22" L
 - Items exceeding these measurements will be checked bags
- Passengers seated in the first row will be limited to one personal item only due to no front seat storage space
- Styrofoam coolers and plastic trash bags are **<u>not allowed</u>** as checked or carry-on baggage
- Items on the <u>TSA Prohibited Item List</u> are <u>not allowed</u> in checked or carry-on baggage
- Hazardous Materials are **not allowed** on aircraft in either checked-in or hand-carried baggage:

Paint; Paint thinner	Matches
Cleaning solvents	Pepper Spray
Sterno fluid	Fire extinguishers

- The carriage of e-cigarettes in <u>not permitted</u> in checked bags. Passengers may carry e-cigarettes in <u>carry-on bags</u>.
- See Battery Information section for prohibition against carrying certain types of batteries in checked bags.
