Dear Commissioners:

Enclosed is a filing for the 10th revision of Sheet No. 5 to Alpine Transportation Company (ATC) Tariff No. 538 to be effective January 1, 2011. ATC will also make a filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) today, November 30, 2010, requesting a similar applicable interstate rate to be effective January 1, 2011. The rate increased from \$.69/bbl to \$.72/bbl due to reduced throughput.

The new tariff was calculated in accordance with the Settlement Agreement approved by the Regulatory Commission of Alaska. An original and ten copies of the Cost of Service Summary, in envelopes marked "Confidential Pursuant to Section I-5 of the Alpine Settlement Agreement," are attached. One copy of a disk with the cost model, a cost of service summary file, and an input/summary file, also marked "Confidential Pursuant to Section I-5 of the Alpine Settlement Agreement" is attached in a similarly marked envelope.

ATC respectfully requests that the tariff filing be allowed to take effect on January 1, 2011, the same date as its FERC rates.
