Supplement No. 2 to F.E.R.C. No. 12 is filed in compliance with the order approving settlement in Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Docket No. IS98-3-000, et al. Supplement No. 2 increases the Quality Bank charges per tenth degree of API gravity, from \$0.0418 to \$0.0450.

Attached to this letter is a copy of the report of the TAPS Quality Bank Administrator that provides the basis for the change in the gravity differential.

It is important that this tariff take effect on July 1, 2008 because TAPS is owned by five pipeline companies, each with a joint undivided interest, and each of the other carriers' tariffs will take effect on July 1, 2008.

A similar filing is being made with the Regulatory Commission of Alaska.


