Supplement No. 2 to FERC Tariff No. 17 corrects Supplement No. 1 to FERC Tariff No. 17 as follows:

- The reference to the authority for the tariff filing on the Title Page of Supplement No. 1 to FERC Tariff No. 17 is corrected to include the cite, docket number and date of the FERC order approving the settlement agreement pursuant to which the rates are filed.
- The reference to the request for special permission on the Title Page of Supplement No. 1 to FERC Tariff No. 17 is corrected to refer to 18 C.F.R. § 341.14 instead of 18 C.F.R. § 341.13, and to indicate that the tariff publication is issued on 17-days’ notice and is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.

Supplement No. 2 to FERC Tariff No. 17 is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.


