ConocoPhillips Transportation Alaska, Inc. (CPTAI) is filing the tariff change shown on the 12th Revised Sheet No. 10 canceling the 11th Revised Sheet No. 10 for CPTAI, as explained herein. This change incorporates Supplement No. 1 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 9. The intrastate filing is filed and requested to be effective July 1, 2006 which is the same effective date as Supplement No. 1 to F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 9.

Supplement No. 1 to F.E.R.C. No. 9 makes changes to the Rules and Regulations by revising and increasing the gravity adjustment in Item 3(a)(3)(iii) from \$0.0364 to \$0.0383 as outlined in the attached Quality Bank Administrator report (attached).

CPTAI requests that the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (Commission) waive the applicable statutory filing period under AS 42.06.390 and 3 AAC 48.300(a)(c) for good cause shown and permit this filing to become effective on shortened time, if necessary. CPTAI requests waiver of the filing requirements contained in 3 AAC 48.805(a) so as to facilitate the implementation of the change on the same day as its F.E.R.C. tariff is to take effect.

CPTAI shippers as well as state agencies are being notified of this filing.
