
This supplement to tariff advice refers to the Local Pipeline Tariff containing the TAPS Quality Bank Methodology for each of the five TAPS Carriers, issued January 17, 2008, with an effective date of February 1, 2008. The Local Pipeline Tariff was filed on January 17, 2008 at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") and with this Commission.

Special permission has been requested of the FERC for these tariffs to become effective on February 1, 2008. The TAPS Carriers request a waiver of the usual 30-day notice requirement for a tariff revision because the tariff adjustments for Light Distillate, Heavy Distillate and Resid in Attachment 2 to the tariffs must be made within less than 30 days, and because it is necessary and desirable for the Quality Bank provisions of the TAPS tariffs on file at the FERC and at this Commission to be identical and to have identical effective dates. Therefore, pursuant to 3 AAC 48.300(c)(4), there is good cause for waiver of the statutory notice and an effective date of February 1, 2008, as these tariff adjustments are being filed to comply with a Commission order.

Thank you for allowing this supplement and the waiver of the usual 30-day notice requirement.
